<b>Required for acceptance:</b>
<b>Medical Insurance</b> - Students must have medical insurance while attending Yeshiva. All associated costs will be covered by the student, including any medical expenses. A policy number must be emailed to the yeshiva before zman starts, and a copy of your insurance card must be provided on the first day of zman.
<b>Student Visa</b> - Students must have a valid student visa while attending Yeshiva. The 3 month visitor's visa will not suffice, and a student visa must be acquired before zman starts, and should be valid for the entire year. Student visas can be arranged in your country of residence and does not have to be done in Eretz Yisrael. The Yeshiva will not acquire the visas for students. You must take care of it yourself.
<b>Talmid Agreement</b> - Students must agree to abide by the rules of the Yeshiva, including the rules that are detailed in the Talmid Agreement (see below).

**Early Leave - Return Fee:**

Our year is divided into two semester for tuition purposes, Sep-Jan and Feb-Jun. A new student may have the first three weeks of his first semester as a grace period to decide if the Yeshiva is for him. If a student decides to leave within these three weeks, 15% of the total tuition (before applied scholarship credit) must be paid.

If a student decides to stay past the three week grace period, he will then owe the entire semester's tuition even if he leaves before the end of the semester. There will only be one grace period, so any other semesters the student attends, the entire semester's tuition will be owed after the first day of attendance.

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1. Tuition Covers dormitory, shiurim, and a catered meal plan. The dormitory is available during all Bein Hazmanim. The meal plan is provided Sunday morning through Friday morning, as well as in Shabbos meals and certain Yom Tov meals (which are announced throughout the year). The meal plan is not available during Bein Hazmanim or fast days. Special diet needs cannot be accommodated.
  2. The tuition fee is an annual tuition cost. Those who will be taking advantage of our installment plan are paying their total annual costs in monthly installments. Therefore, those on the installment plan will be paying their monthly installment even during Bein Hazmanim.
  3. MASA Grants are available to anyone who is visiting Eretz Yisroel to learn for the first time.
  4. Eligibility for MASA Scholarship is based on an income of less than \$22,500 per household member.
  5. Some independent study, participation and tests are required.

## Talmid Agreement

### TORAH & AVODA

1. All three Sedarim and Minyanim are obligatory and will be strictly enforced.
2. Friday Seder is until 11:00AM.
3. In Shabbos must be attended unless you receive special permission.
4. Befitting true kavod haTorah, a bachur is expected to dress accordingly. Therefore in the Beis Medrash all shirts must be tucked in and a jacket must be worn for davening. Wearing a hat for davening comes very highly recommended.
5. As part of our personal growth and tikkun hamidos program every talmid is responsible to fulfill certain zechusim (chores) once a week in the upkeep of the yeshiva.
6. Responsibility to oneself and to the Yeshiva demands a conduct that befits a true Ben Torah **wherever one is**. Drinking alcoholic beverages tends very much to conflict with these goals. It is therefore the Yeshiva policy to strictly prohibit drinking alcoholic beverages anywhere on their premises without supervision or permission of the Hanhalla. Even outside the Yeshiva we expect every Bochur to be sensitive to ensure that such behavior will not cause a chilul Hashem or defame your Yeshiva. If this rule is treated lightly, unfortunately one will not be allowed to remain in the Yeshiva.
7. All secular literature and magazines are prohibited from being brought into the Yeshiva or dormitory premises.

### DORMITORY

1. There is no smoking allowed on Yeshiva premises including the dormitory, courtyard, or sidewalks adjacent to the Yeshiva building.
2. One may not talk or use a cell phone in the courtyard between the hours of 8:30PM and 8:00AM. We must be sensitive to our neighbors.
3. One is not allowed to change rooms or move yeshiva furniture from one room to another without prior permission from the Yeshiva's Hanhalla.
4. One cannot lend beds to guests without the prior permission from the Yeshiva's Hanhalla.
5. All electronic devices that have capabilities of receiving internet or playing videos are absolutely forbidden. This includes cell phones, iPod's, laptops, etc. The Yeshiva will provide daily access to emails and filtered internet on a dedicated computer. This rule if treated lightly will not allow one to remain in the yeshiva without consequences.
6. Any personal items and belongings that are left in the Yeshiva will become the Yeshiva property after each zman and will be at the Yeshiva's discretion as to how to dispose of them.
7. No Students may leave the country throughout the year for family obligations or otherwise, without the express consent from the administration.

I have read the above rules and expectations of the Yeshiva from me and hereby accept fully the responsibility to keep them. I will abide by all the rules and regulations set by Yeshiva Zeev HaTorah for the health and safety of the student. I understand that if I fail to do so, the decision of my remaining in the Yeshiva or the dormitory will be left up to the discretion of the Hanhalah as they see fit. I also accept to fulfill any obligations (if applicable) as agreed between my parents and the Yeshiva such as Datot, MJJ, etc. I also understand that tuition does not cover food outside of the Yeshiva meal plan, special diets needs, use of washer and dryer, etc. I acknowledge that Yeshiva is not responsible for the loss or damage of my personal property. I also acknowledge that it is my responsibility and חייב to have medical coverage while learning at Yeshiva Zeev HaTorah and that the Yeshiva is not responsible for any medical related expenses.

I will do my utmost not to be עובר on גזל by shutting off lights, fans, heaters, water, etc. when I leave my dorm room, etc. I am also aware that any personal items which I may accidentally leave behind will be considered הפקר after 30 days and will become the property of the Yeshiva. I grant Yeshiva Zeev HaTorah permission to disperse or dispose of any personal property left by me upon my departure from the program.
